Students were added to Moodle in April:

#### Goal:

Create a connection between Shinshu University and CU virtually through VIEs.

# **Student Objectives:**

- I can discuss topics in English with non-native English speakers (CU students) / with native English speakers (Shinsu students)
- I can discuss topics in Japanese with non-native Japanese speakers (CU students) / with native Japanese speakers (Shinsu students)
- I can introduce myself to native speakers in their native language

#### Results:

- Question 1: Similarities with their foreign peers.
   Results: before interaction 3.8 (Peru & Mexico 2.9)
- Question 2: More differences before and after study.
   Results: before 4.2 (Peru 4.2, Mexico 3.8)
- Question 3: Study expected to rate their intercultural competency. Although the term "competency" was not defined, the students reported higher intercultural competency.

Results: before interaction 2.4 (Peru 3.2, Mexico 2.7)

Question 4: Mutual foreign peer intercultural competency.
 Results: before interaction 3.6 (*Peru 3.5, Mexico 2.8*)

### **Future expectations:**

A 3-8 week exchange for the fall is currently being planned. We plan to incorporate VoiceThread to create a more asynchronous engaging experience due to the time zone difference instead of the personal interviews in Skype or Zoom.
